THE ARTISTS

LUVANGA

Born in Geneva and raised in the Lignon district, the Swiss-Congolese producer-composer LUVANGA, whose name means "the one who does what he wants" in Kikongo, develops a unique form of Afrofuturism. From his childhood, steeped in rumba, reggae, and hip hop thanks to his family, he displayed an early talent for composition. As a teenager, he diversified his musical influences, venturing into soul, jazz, pop, and funk, while exploring Afro-American music and playing the piano in an African gospel group.

His passion and talent for music led him to win the beatmaking prize at the Music Producer Challenge in 2019, followed by a victory in a remix contest for Les Amazones d'Afrique the next year, with the Real World label. These successes marked a turning point, prompting him to reconnect with his African roots and experiment with various genres like Afrobeats, Amapiano, and Gnawa, culminating in the creation of three EPs and a series of singles influenced by these styles, including "Where Is My Money" and "Nakei." His rise continued has he was shortlisted for the Grammy Awards 2024 in 4 categories.

LUVANGA skillfully merges his cultural heritage with contemporary influences, blending traditional instruments with modern genres to create rich and innovative music. His recent project, Seben of Luv, rejuvenates the **Seben** style of rumba, linking it to contemporary genres and showcasing his vision of a musical future where the tribal meets the modern. LUVANGA thus embodies a bridge between the **past** and the future, where music serves as a temporal exploration.

SEKZY

born in 1995 in Montserrado, Monrovia, **Liberia**, grew up in a small town called Lola in Guinea Conakry. During his teenage years, he moved to **Switzerland**, where he began to develop his talent for art and music. The depth of his music reflects his past, where he chose to give up his great passion, football, to advance in music.

In a short period, he became locally known for his smoothness, voice, and the rhythms he creates by blending Afrobeat and Dancehall into a style he calls "Afrohall."

He describes his music as follows: "My art has no form; it is uncontrollable, a combination of many elements in fusion. My personality is also very different from what you can see in my music videos!

Each person can perceive me differently..."
